

**Ames Family Hospice House
Crocker and Clemens Roads, Westlake, Ohio**



PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Ames Family Hospice House will provide a home-like environment for our seriously-ill patients who need intensive short-term symptom management and for those with no available caregiver or whose family is unable to care for them at home.

QUICK FACTS:

- 32 patient rooms
- Approximately 40,000 square feet
- Ground breaking in early 2011
- Estimated completion in summer 2012

SITE

- Ames Family Hospice House will be located on a 30-acre property in Westlake, at the corner of Crocker and Clemens Roads.
- The location will be easily accessed from I-90. Amenities nearby include lodging, food service, shopping and Cleveland Hopkins International Airport.
- Existing running trails on the property will remain accessible to the public once construction is complete.

BUILDING DESIGN

- Ames Family Hospice House will be designed in a Craftsman-inspired style and will be constructed of a natural blend of stone and brick, which will allow the building to fit in with its surroundings.
- The facility was designed by Hospice Design Resource, which specializes in hospice facilities. Vocon, a local architectural firm, is the architect of record.
- Donley's is serving as construction manager, with the Sanchez Group serving as Owner's Representative.
- The building will incorporate environmentally-friendly construction techniques.
